## MAINTENANCE GUIDE

## TO KEEP YOUR CORIAN COUNTERTOP IN GOOD SHAPE, YOU CAN FOLLOW THESE STEPS:

- Use a soft cloth or sponge to remove dust and dirt from the surface of the countertop. Do not
  use abrasive powders or other harsh cleaners, as this can damage the surface
- 2. Wipe the countertop with a dry cloth to remove any residue of dirt and water.
- Use a mild soap or cleaner to clean the countertop. Avoid aggressive cleaning agents, as they can damage the surface.
- 4. Rinse the countertop with clean water and then dry it with a dry cloth.
- If the countertop has deep scratches or damage, you can use a Corian repair kit to fill the scratches and smooth the surface. Follow the instructions in the kit closely to ensure the best possible result.
- 6. Avoid placing hot pots and pans directly on the countertop, as this can damage the surface. Instead, use heat-resistant trivets, such as pot holders or heat-resistant cups.
- 7. Do not use sharp objects, such as knives or cutting tools, directly on the countertop, as this can damage the surface. Instead, use cutting boards to protect the countertop.
- 8. If the countertop becomes discolored or sun-bleached, you can use a soft, damp cloth with mild soap or cleaner to clean the surface. Then dry it with a dry cloth.
- If the countertop gets stained with food or beverages, such as wine or coffee, you should remove the stains immediately by using a soft cloth with clean water. Then wipe the countertop with a dry cloth.
- 10. To maintain the shine and prolong the lifespan of your Corian countertop, it is recommended to apply a surface protectant or wax once a year. Follow the instructions on the product closely to ensure the best possible result.
