MAINTENANCE GUIDE

TO KEEP YOUR STONE COUNTERTOP IN GOOD SHAPE, YOU CAN FOLLOW THESE STEPS:

- 1. Clean regularly with a soft cloth and water. Avoid using cleaners with abrasives or other sharp objects, as this can damage the surface.
- 2. Dry the countertop thoroughly after cleaning to avoid water spots.
- 3. Use a marble cleaner regularly to remove deep stains and discolorations. Always follow the manufacturer's instructions.
- 4. Protect the countertop with a surface protectant to make it resistant to stains and damage.
- 5. Avoid placing hot food directly on the marble countertop. Instead, use a heat-resistant trivet.
- 6. Avoid placing sharp objects on the countertop, as this can damage the surface.
- 7. Be aware that marble is a porous material, so it may be necessary to refresh the surface with a new layer of protectant a few times a year.
- 8. If the countertop develops deep scratches, it can be cleaned and polished by a professional to make it look new again.
